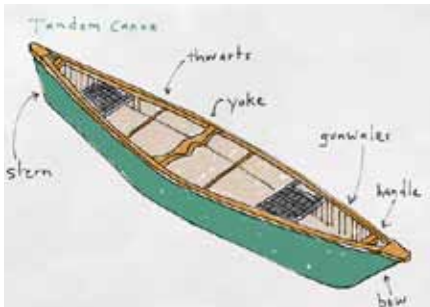
Garbage and Recycling:

- Please use our compost bins for vegetable food scraps while you are here. No meat, please! (It attracts animals.)
- You are required to take your non-compostable garbage and your recyclables to the Schroon Lake dump/landfill.
- Free dump/landfill Tickets
We have them available for your use. Please take one with you.
- The following items are recyclable:
 - Glass
 - All Plastic
 - Tin Cans and metal
 - Paper, cardboard and cardboard box board
- Dump/landfill hours

Power Outage

- During a electrical power outage, water supply will be affected. The septic is also affected.
- Please note that the three lakeside cottages toilets cannot be flushed because all waste is pumped uphill electrically.
- It is best leave your refrigerator and freezer closed.

WATERFRONT SAFETY/BOATS/LIFEJACKETS

Swimming and Buoy Lines

- All children in the water must be supervised by an adult on the beach or in the water.
- Buoy lines suggest the safety area for small children.
- There is a large boulder outcropping called The Point. It is steep and can be slippery. The water is deep on both sides.



We advise you to accompany your child(children) when they are on The Point.

Boats

- Children in boats must be accompanied or closely supervised by adults.



- We provide rowboats, kayaks and canoes free of charge. Boats are shared by all guests.

Life Vests/Life Jackets - Who must wear one?

- Everyone!
- All Ages, at all times!
- Be sure the jacket/vest fits properly!

SEPTIC SYSTEM

The cottages at SunderLand were built on granite outcroppings which are part of the rugged beauty of the Adirondacks, but make our septic system fragile and expensive to maintain. All of the sewage from the lakeside cabins is pumped uphill. Any breakdown in this system can result in a nasty, expensive inconvenience and spoiled vacation.

Toilets can handle human waste and toilet paper ONLY.



NO:

Tampons

Panty Liners

Paper towels

Baby Wipes or any kind of “flushable” wipes

“Flushable” diapers

Excessive amounts of toilet paper

Please take short showers and flush toilets only when necessary!

If anything besides human waste or toilet paper goes into the toilet unintentionally, it must be removed **BEFORE** the toilet is flushed. If you can't remove it, please notify **Susan, Rick, or Toni.**

Campfires and Grills

Cooking fires

- Cooking fires are allowed only in the barbecue grills provided.
- Please keep a bucket of water by your barbecue grill when you are cooking, and do not leave the fire unattended.



Camp Fires

- Camp fires are restricted to the fire pit in the beach area. Fires must be started by an adult.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all campfires.
- Two large buckets of water are to be kept in the vicinity of the campfire at all times. They can be refilled with lake water.
- Please allow your campfire to burn low at the end of the evening, and douse it thoroughly before leaving it.
- If you are at the campfire past 10 PM, please be considerate of guests who may be trying to sleep.

General Info

Quiet Times and being considerate

- Among the many pleasures that we enjoy in this environment are the natural sounds of water lapping the shore; of frogs, birds, and crickets; the crackling campfire; the laughter of children and the sounds of people talking and making music together.
- Out of consideration for others, we ask that if you play electronic games or listen to recorded music, you keep the volume down or use headphones and avoid anything else that makes loud noises.
- When you return to your cottage later than 10 PM, please keep in mind that others may be sleeping
- ! Cap guns, fire crackers, fireworks and sparklers are not permitted here!

Dinners with others:

- Please remember, when you take cookware, dishes, or silverware to another cabin, it needs to be returned to its original place.

Drinking water

- Is it OK to drink water from the tap? Yes! The water comes from a NYS inspected well. By law it is chlorinated.

Fishing

- A New York State license is required over the age of 16

Day and Overnight Guests:

- Only the people specified in your reservation are permitted to use the cottage and the grounds.

We can suggest other sites where our guests can get together with friends, such as public parks, the Schroon Lake beach, or one of the numerous family hiking trails or other attractions.

Our first commitment is to the comfort of our guests, and adherence to Department of Health capacity stipulations. For those reasons, day or overnight visitors are permitted **only** by permission of the owners.

Leaving

When you leave:

- Leaving time
We ask that you leave your cottage by 10:30
- Your efforts to leave your cabin clean are very helpful to us.
Please see cleaning list in your cottage.
- If you have any food or beverages that you don't want to take with you, please leave them outside the door of Beehive (the office).
- If you need to stop at the dump/landfill on your way home, please take a ticket with you and leave any unused portion with the attendant.
